Q1) Which academic boards are you associated with?

EuroSchool Thane offers curriculum in accordance with the ICSE Board. Select EuroSchools also offer the CAIE, Cambridge Assessment International Education (IGCSE).

Q2) What are the different subjects offered at the school?

Students are exposed to a variety of subjects such as English, Hindi, regional language, Mathematics, Social Science, ICT (Information & Communication Technology) and Environmental Science at the primary level. English Literature, English Language, Mathematics, Hindi, Regional Language, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, History-Civics, Geography, Economics, Commercial Studies, Commercial Applications and Computer Applications are taught at the middle school and secondary levels.

Q3) What co-curricular activities are offered to the students?

The learning experience for the student is made fun and engaging through co-curricular activities such as Taekwondo, Skating, Gymnastics, Contemporary Dance, Light Music and Physical Education. In addition, students can choose from a variety of activities offered in the Fine Art Club, Sports Club and Academic Clubs with diverse options. Academic clubs offer a variety of options such as Astronomy, Quiz, Mathematics, English Literary Club, Nature Club, Nutrition Science, Environment & Sustainable Development, Astronomy, Quiz, Human Rights, IT, Leadership, MUN, Cinematic Art & Appreciation and Media Studies. The Fine Art Club gives opportunities to students to learn musical instruments, Kathak, contemporary dance, art & craft & Robotics.

Q4) What transport facilities do you offer?

We offer convenient transportation facilities within Thane city, with school buses that provide pick-up and drop options. Our buses have GPS systems to track the movement of the buses and mandatory female attendants on all buses during transportation to ensure safety of the students.

Q5) What are the days of functioning and timings of the school?

The school functions from Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 2:45 p.m.

Q6) When does the admission season begin?

The admission season begins in September every year for the next academic year. We also have mid-term admissions for the on-going academic year, between the months of June and October.



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Q7) What are the different activities that the students can be a part of?

The Schools have a host of clubs, like academic, non-academic and sports. Students can choose to be a part of an activity of their choice under each of these clubs. Students also get to use the indoor and outdoor sports facilities to excel in not just academics, but also in sports activities of their choice.

Q8) What is the teacher-student ratio in the classrooms?

Teacher-student ratio remains at 1:34 in our Primary and Secondary classes while the Pre-primary classes have two teachers for a group of 34 students. This ensures optimal teacher-student engagement and ensures that all students are given individual attention.

Q9) How do you make sure your teachers are up-to-date in their teaching methods?

Our teachers continuously go through training and skill upgradation through ETAT – the EuroSchool Teacher Assessment Tool, which is a mandatory online teacher Assessment platform. At EuroSchool, all the teachers are provided with 60 hours of professional development and training for both Soft Skills and Content. Our proprietary ETAT ensures that each teacher meets the required norms of content mastery at EuroSchool through our professional development and teacher training program.

Q10) How can parents stay informed about the on-goings at school?

At EuroSchool, we believe that parents are co-partners in their child's growth and development. Hence, the school keeps parents informed and involved at all times through Webgenie - a dedicated mobile app for each school. Through this app, parents view the weekly assignments, worksheets and homework given. It also updates the parents about the latest events and activities planned for the year.

Q11) How often do parents get to meet the teachers to get an update on the progress their child is making?

EuroSchool believes in a parent inclusive program. Thus, we have periodic Parent - Teacher meetings and workshops. We also have an online report card system called Report Bee that allows parents to view the status of their child's progress online, analyse strength areas and identify areas for improvement.

Q12) What are the safety measures undertaken at the school?

EuroSchool lays special emphasis on providing a safe learning environment for every child and our campuses have been certified as India's 1st Certified Network of Safe Schools.



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The entire campus is under CCTV surveillance supported with a dedicated safety team, Safety Marshalls at school and lady attendants in every school bus. Furthermore, we follow a strict anti-bullying and anti-ragging philosophy and sensitise children towards the same. Our hiring process follows a stringent safety protocol. All teachers and administrative staff go through police verification, background checks and previous employer check. In the event of an emergency, we have dedicated emergency evacuation plans and highlighted safety exits.

Q13) Do you have any initiatives towards the health and wellness of the child at school? What are they?

With growing emphasis on optimal child's development, safety and wellness, EuroSchool has entered into a strategic association with Surya Hospitals to provide premier healthcare services and specialised medical options to students and parents. Through this association, we help with a gamut of health and wellness services like general health check-up by paediatricians, ENT, dental examinations, height, weight, BMI analysis; maintenance of health records and health cards. Additionally, in case of special cases, a dedicated team of experts at Surya Hospital will also give 2nd level support to parents of the students through e-mail and a dedicated helpline number.

Q 14) Do you have a nurse on staff?

Every EuroSchool campus has a dedicated Medical Room called the "INFIRMARY" with a trained nurse who is available to the students during school hours.

Q15) What provisions do you make for special needs kids?

Inclusive education is something that EuroSchool strongly promotes and thus special needs children who require specific guidance are mentored and helped with specialised counselling & workshop sessions. These sessions are aimed towards supporting children with special needs through remedial work and counselling sessions for parents & children to optimise their strengths and work on skills which help them achieve their potential.

Q16) Do you have a canteen facility or do kids have to bring lunch from home?

EuroSchool Thane has cafeteria facilities available in the School premises where well-balanced vegetarian snacks and meals are served. In accordance with our policies and philosophy of healthy living at EuroSchool, we advice parents, who send across meals from home, to only provide vegetarian and healthy meals and avoid junk food.
