English, Commerce, Accounts, Mathematics, Political Science, and Economics:

Paper I: Theory - 80 marks Paper II: Project Work-20 marks.

English: The subject English has two components, English Language and Literature in English. Theory: A composition, Directed writing (article writing, book review, and film review, review of cultural programme, speech writing, report writing, personal profile and statement of purpose) based on suggested points, Proposal Writing based on a given situation, Comprehension.

Commerce: Business Environment, Financing, Management and Marketing. Carry out 2 projects

Accounts: Partnership Accounts, Dissolution of a Partnership firm, Joint Stock Company Accounts, Financial Statement Analysis, Cash Flow Statement (Only for Manufacturing Companies), Ratio Analysis, Accounting Application of Electronic Spread Sheet, Database Management System (DBMS)

Mathematics: Relations and Functions, Algebra, Calculus, Probability, Three - Dimensional Geometry, Applications of Integrals, Application of Calculus, Linear Regression and Linear Programming

Political Science: Constitution and Government, Organs of the Government, Indian Democracy, Indian Constitution, Fundamental Rights and Directive Principles, Local self-government

Economics: Micro Economic Theory, Theory of Income and Employment, Money and banking, Balance of Payment and Exchange Rate, Public Finance, National Income

Psychology, Computer science:

Paper I - Theory: 3 hours, 70 marks Paper II- Practical Work: 30 marks

Psychology: Intelligence and Ability, Personality, Lifespan development, Psychological Disorders and Psychotherapy, Stress and Stress Management, Social Thought and Social Behaviour, Attitudes, Applications of Psychology. Topics for practical's - To study attitudinal differences, to study group differences in Examination results, to study the causes and effects of stress among school students

Chemistry: Paper I: Solid State, Solutions ,Electrochemistry , Chemical Kinetics , Surface Chemistry ,General Principles and Processes of Isolation of Elements , p-Block Elements , d -and f -Block Elements , Coordination Compounds , Haloalkanes and Haloarenes , Alcohols, Phenols and Ethers , Aldehydes, Ketones and CarboxylicAcids , Organic Compounds containing Nitrogen , Biomolecules , Chemistry in Everyday Life

Biology: Reproduction, Genetics and Evolution, Biology and Human Welfare, Biotechnology and its Applications, Ecology and Environment

Physical Education: Paper I: Theory-70 marks, Paper II: Practical Work-30 marks. Sociological Aspects of Physical Education, Training Methods, Career Aspects in Physical Education, Competitions and Tournaments, Health Education & Health Problems, Sports Injuries and First Aid. Any two of the following games are to be studied: Cricket, Football, Hockey, Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton, Tennis, Swimming, Athletics
